Can't I just turn up?

For insurance and safety reasons we need to keep accurate records of attendance at each rehearsal or event. This is to protect you and the other members should anything go wrong. It is for this reason we need to record details for all our members.

How much does it cost?

Per Month

Participation in a *With One Voice* choir is by modest tax-deductible donation. We have several different payment options, so you can choose the one that works best for you.
